

# EXPERIENCE NEW ORLEANS ON A STREETCAR

Streetcars are ubiquitous in New Orleans. Whether you are walking in the French Quarter, enjoying a day at City Park, or exploring Uptown, you are bound to hear the clickity-clack of a streetcar gliding along its rail. They weave right into the scenery of the city and are intertwined with the history of New Orleans.

- The St. Charles line (green) is the oldest, continuously operating streetcar line in the world. Opened in 1835, this line runs from Canal Street in the Central Business District to South Claiborne Avenue in the Historic Carrollton District. Select green streetcars are ADA compliant and are marked as such on the exterior.
- The Canal line (red) runs from the Riverfront to City Park via Carrollton Avenue and the Cemeteries Transit Center. Red streetcars are all ADA compliant.



## Jazzy Pass

Jazzy Passes are the most convenient, cost-effective option for using transit. Jazzy Passes provide unlimited rides on RTA buses, streetcars, and ferries for the number of consecutive days purchased.

- 3-Day Jazzy Pass\* .....\$8.00
- 7-Day Jazzy Pass\* .....\$15.00

## Group Purchases

### Mobile Jazzy Pass

We recommend that your groups purchase their passes in advance using a web portal assigned to your group. This secure link allows you to distribute Jazzy Passes via email to your registrants. Their pass becomes available for use within the Le Pass app. Please contact us for more information on how we can get this started for your group.

### Paper Jazzy Pass with Magnetic Strip

For groups that would like to purchase our magnetic strip paper passes in advance and distribute them to participants at the time of registration, we can sell passes in advance of your event. Please contact us for more information on how we can get this started for your group.

## Hours

Streetcars run 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. During your stay, you can track your streetcar with real-time arrival information available on the Le Pass app or at [norta.com](http://norta.com). PDF schedules are available on [norta.com](http://norta.com) and printed copies are available at various locations around the city.
